Please arrive by 11am for your duty. A normal kiddush preparation includes setting up and washing up - we do not use any plastic crockery or cutlery- and leaving the kitchen clean and tidy and wiping the serving table. All left-over food should be put in airtight containers and stored in fridge or cupboard whichever is appropriate. **Both the fridge and whisky/knife/dishwasher cupboard need to be left locked using the combination lock.**

We are using the dishwasher weekly. Please rinse and place all kiddush glasses, plates, cutlery etc in the dishwasher. It will be run after Shabbat and items can be used directly from there for the next kiddush.

Please also let me know if we are running short of anything. We cannot use dishes or utensils belonging to Langdon College.
